

These stages can be linked either by walking along the Kennet & Avon Canal towpath, or by train for Great Bedwyn, Hungerford, and Kintbury. Naturally, you are advised to check timetables and plan accordingly.



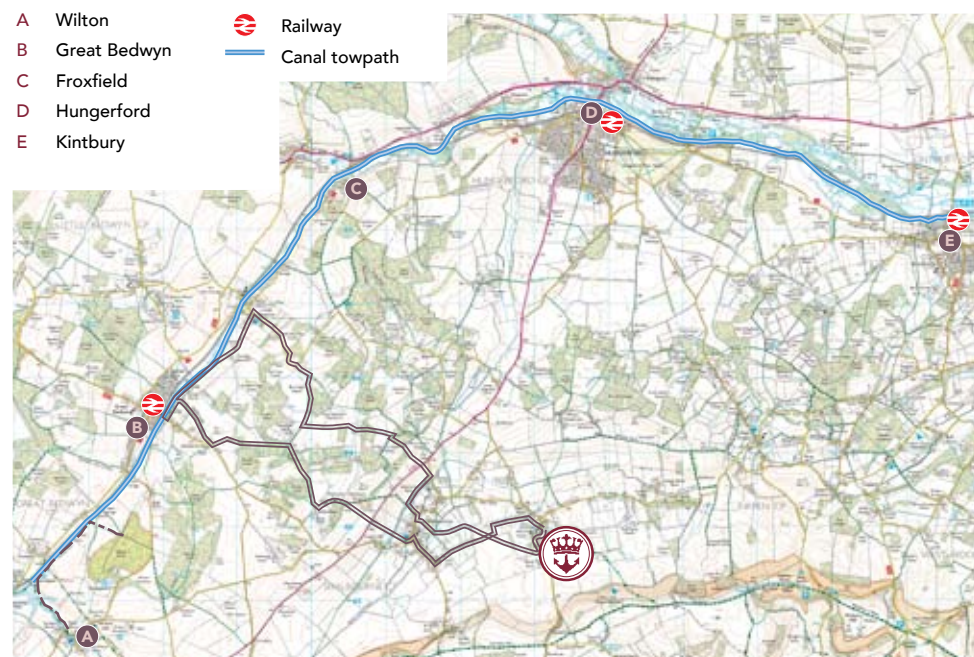
Along the canal towpath

Wilton	1.5m/2.5km
Froxfield	2.6m/4.2km
Hungerford	4.8m/7.8km
Kintbury	7.9m/12.8km

Link to Hungerford and Kintbury by rail.

WALK 15

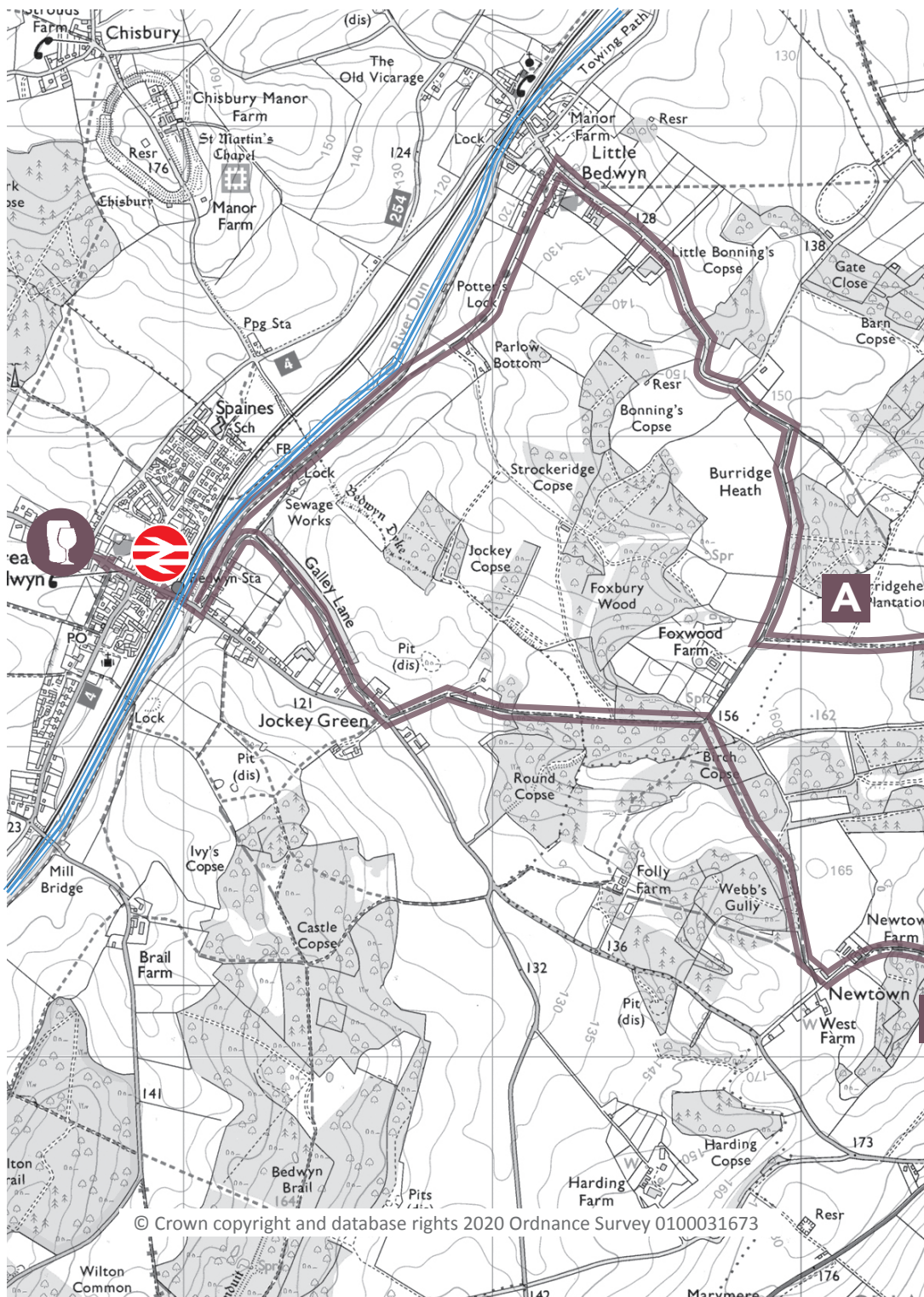
GREAT BEDWYN

via Shalbourne and Little Bedwyn : 5.5 miles/ 9 km: 2 hours
Moderate walking conditions, some inclines

via Newtown: 5 miles/ 8 km: 2 hours
Moderate walking conditions, some inclines

Total 10.5 miles/17 km : 4 hours walking

*Can be considered either as a circular walk from Ham,
or as alternative ways of covering a stage on a linked walk (see back of leaflet).*
