These stages can be linked either by walking along the Kennet & Avon Canal towpath, or by train for Great Bedwyn, Hungerford, and Kintbury. Naturally, you are advised to check timetables and plan accordingly.




## Along the canal towpath

via Inkpen: 5.5 miles/9 km: 2 hours Mostly level with some inclines

via Totterdown: 6 miles/10 km: 2 hours Mostly level with some inclines

Total 11.5 miles/19 km: 4 hours walking

Can be considered either as a circular walk from Ham, or as alternative ways of covering a stage on a linked walk (see back of leaflet).
