A varied walk, initially along the tarred lane, then through Ham Hill Nature Reserve, briefly along a drovers road with wonderful views across the Kennet valley, through the hamlet of Buttermere, the woodlands and pastures of Buttermere Bottom, the quaint Buttermere Church, back to the drovers road along the top of the downs and thence to Ham village.

Take a packed lunch as there is no pub until you get back to the Crown & Anchor.
